RESUME NANI MEDEIROS

Nani Medeiros is a Brazilian singer from Porto Alegre, Rio Grande do Sul. She has been working with music since 2012. In 2014 she released her first EP, with the same name, and in October 2017 her first album. An album of unreleased songs, by new composers of Brazilian Popular Music, entitled "Valentia" released by the independent label Loop Discos and available on the main digital platforms.

Nani's musical roots lie in the genres of Brazilian Popular Music, such as choro, samba, songs and bossa nova.

She has worked on several projects, including the musicals: "Lupi - O Musical, Uma Vida Em Estado de Paixão" (about the life and work of Lupicínio Rodrigues, premiered at the São Pedro Theatre), "O Maestro, O Malandro & O Poeta (about the composers Tom Jobim, Chico Buarque and Vinicius de Moraes), "Estação Brasil - A Música Brasileira na Era do Rádio", and projects she conceived, such as the special "Essa Mulher - Nani Medeiros canta Elis Regina", among others.

Her main references include great artists from Portuguese-speaking music, such as: Elis Regina, Clara Nunes, Nana Caymmi, Elizeth Cardoso, Amália Rodrigues, Césaria Évora, Maria Teresa de Noronha, Carminho, Ana Moura, among others.

Since 2016, Nani has delved into Portuguese culture through the musical universe of Fado, a genre that has a huge dialog with other musical references in Nani's career, such as Samba-Canção and Choro. Since 2016, she has performed in various Brazilian cities, extolling Portuguese culture and also in Portugal, Spain, Germany, Greece and China.

In March 2019, Nani Medeiros was nominated for the Açorianos Music Award in the best MPB performer category for her debut album "Valentia". In 2019 she moved to Lisbon and took part in the SuperBok em Estoque festival "Rua das Pretas invites Nani Medeiros" at the Casa do Alentejo in Lisbon; in the same year she presented the concert "Valentia" at the Casino Estoril.

In 2020 she premiered the concert "Fado & Samba Canção" with guitarist Pedro de Castro, guitarist João Pita and fado singer Zé Maria in the concert program of the renowned Real Fado project; she also premiered the concert "Saudades do Brasil em Portugal" with fado singer Ana Sofia Varela at the Amália Rodrigues house-museum, in partnership with the Amália Rodrigues Foundation; she recorded the album "Um copo de fado dois de bossa nova" by the Lusophone artists' collective Rua das Pretas; later that year she took part in the reopening of Lisbon's Coliseu dos Recreios with the Rua das Pretas collective's concert alongside Maria João and Tito Paris.

In May 2021 she took part in the concert in honor of World Portuguese Language Day "Sons Lusófonos" alongside fado singers Rodrigo Costa Félix and Cristina Clara, which was held at the Portuguese Consulate in Seville.

In 2022 he performed the concert "Travessia | Fado, Choro e outras brasilidades" at the opening of the Samos Young Artists Festival, organized by the Schwarz Foundation on the island of Samos (Greece); he also performed the Samba and Choro concert at the Chorinho Cultural Association in Nuremberg. Also in 2022, he took part in the concert celebrating the 55th anniversary of fado singer João Braga's career, which was performed at the São Luiz theater in Lisbon.

In 2023 he gave a sold-out premiere at the Casa de Francisca in São Paulo, Brazil, of the concert Fado Tropical with the participation of Felipe Catto. Still in Brazil that same year, he presented the concert "Nos Horizontes do Mundo - A música de Paulinho da Viola" at the São Paulo Cultural Center. In November 2023 he took part in the Lusofonia Festival in Macau - China, as part of the "A Gafieira" project. In December he performed the concert "Travessia" in the main hall of the Portuguese Consulate in Seville (Spain).

In April 2024, with his duo alongside guitarist João Pita, he performed at the Guimarães Rosa Cultural Institute - Embassy of Brazil in Rome, Italy. In May he premiered the concert "Cantos de (para) liberdade" at the José Saramago Foundation in Lisbon. Also in May, he released his latest album, the EP "Travessia", which initially featured the release of two singles, the samba song "Saber Mentir" and the unreleased bossa "Música". He is currently working on a new album, produced by João Pita and Roberto Didio and featuring

Cristóvão Bastos, João Camarero, Miguel Rabello and Elodie Bouny, with unreleased songs by various composers, including Dori Caymmi, Roberto Didio, Miguel Rabello, João Camarero and Cristóvão Bastos, among others. He is also a member of the cast of the Fama de Alfama fado house, where he presents his Fado and Choro project.
